A SNIPPET FROM THE YEAR BOOK OF PRAYER: At Riverside Church in Detroit weekly worship ends with the charge, "As you have been fed by the word of God, go and feed those that hunger on the streets of our community." Worshipers take this injunction literally, for as they depart they pick up sack lunches to distribute to those living on the streets just outside the door. In addition, outreach is provided to students and faculty at nearby Wayne State University inviting them to Riverside's coffeehouse atmosphere with weekday offerings of Bible study and meditative yoga. Efforts are being made to provide a place of refuge for young men who have aged out of foster care.
