### ~~ MISSION, SERVICE & GRANTS ~~

**A SNIPPET FROM THE YEAR BOOK OF PRAYER:** Young Adult Volunteers (YAV) have been serving in south India since 1998. They live with communities---often poor and disadvantaged--with whom they live, eat, and work. They have no money to dole out nor do they have ample knowledge of the local language, culture, and neighborhood. Vulnerable, they depend on the hospitality of the communities, receiving more than they give. Yet through simple acts of love, they transform the lives of those around them who otherwise would remain unattended. The YAV program is an example of genuine mission in Christ's way.

**BREAD FOR THE WORLD** literature informs us that in 2005 half of all African-American children, 46 percent of Hispanic children and 18 percent of white children were in families that did not qualify at all or qualified for less than the full amount of the Child Tax Credit. This credit is worth up to \$1,000 for each child under age 17 claimed on a worker's tax return. It provides close to \$50 billion to families with children every year. Until recently, this credit was not available to families with incomes below \$11,300, meaning nearly 10 million children living in poverty did not benefit from the credit. Our letter urges Congress to ensure that recent improvements stay in place beyond their 2010 expiration.
